Fortunately, her incredible musical legacy lives on through the striking talents of Gesenia Gerena and her band, the Ronstadt Revue.

Born in Paterson, New Jersey and raised in Philadelphia, South Jersey's professional singing talent Gesenia began her career without formal training, but with stunning recognition. At 25, she earned her first professional singing paycheck and quickly moved on to record her first CD "Mi Sueño", in the early 2004. Though family and health obligations momentarily sidetracked her career, much like Ronstadt herself, Gesenia rediscovered her love of music and of Linda Ronstadt's music.

She first envisioned launching a Ronstadt tribute show in early 2016. Gesenia says that she "felt a void out there with regard to the music of Linda Ronstadt and wanted to fill it with something very special", spending more than a year searching for the right musicians to fully showcase Ronstadt's music, from country rock to mariachi to big band to pop rock. The result of those efforts is Ronstadt Revue — the world's finest Linda Ronstadt tribute show.

Each member of the band is a seasoned, talented musician fully dedicated to recreating the sounds and vibe of a Linda Ronstadt live performance from back in the day. Joining her on stage to perform are Nick Frese (bass guitar and vocals), Bob Leonetti (electric and acoustic guitar and vocals), Jim Cohen (pedal steel and electric guitar), David Lenat (lead guitar, banjo, and resonator), Dave Hartl (piano, accordion, and harmonica) and Tim Reeder (drums, percussion and backing vocals).



While Gesenia and her band work diligently to record two new CDs, expected to be released in late 2022 or early 2023, the Ronstadt Revue is engaged in performances throughout the US, including one upcoming performance on August 27th at 8pm at the historic Landis Theater, located at the 830 E Landis Avenue in Vineland, NJ.

As of press-time, a few tickets remained available for that performance and can be purchased online, at https://www.thelandistheater.com/shows-events-1. You can hear an interview with Gesenia on the New Jersey Free Press' broadcast "Taking Care of Business", scheduled to air live on Saturday August 20th from 11:30 am to noon, on radio station WVLT, 92.1 FM, in Vineland. Along with co-producer and co-writer Leon Huff and the beautiful orchestral arrangements of Thom Bell, who co-wrote with Poogie Hart many of the Delfonics hits, such as "Didn't I Blow Your Mind This Time" and "La-La Means I Love You," it amounted to a brand new sound in love songs that was elegant and timeless..No wonder the Delfonics were the key element of the soundtrack for the wonderful adult love story at the center of Quentin Tarantino's film "Jackie Brown."

I dedicated a recent "Rock and Roll, Rhythm & Blues **Express**" show on **WXPN** to the legend of the **Delfonics** and other great groups that represented TSOP, and also to the genius of Thommie Bell. Jerry Blavat is one of America's leading, most recognized and most respected disc jockeys and performer who has been the leading influence in the proliferation of "oldies" music on the radio and internet for decades. A respected Philadelphia icon, he gained local fame hosting live dances in the area, leading to his own independent radio show, on which he introduced many acts in the 1960s to a wide audience, including the Four Seasons and the Isley Brothers. In 1993, Blavat was inducted into the Philadelphia Music Alliance's Hall of Fame, and in 1998, was included in the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame as part of a permanent exhibit in its Museum of Radio and Records. In 2002, he was inducted into the Broadcast Pioneers of Philadelphia's "Hall of Fame", and on January 15, 2022, Blavat celebrated his 61st consecutive year on radio.





CUMBERLAND COUNTY - Taxation Scam Alert For Cumberland County Residents | Cumberland County Division of Consumer Affairs has issued an alert to County

residents that residents of Cumberland County are receiving mailed notices from a "Tax Resolution Unit of Cumberland County Public Judgment Records".

THIS IS A SCAM.

There is no such county department or unit, and this scam is an attempt to scare residents into paying a fake tax debt.



Multiple law enforcement and consumer protection agencies across the country have reported similar scams. The notice appears to be a distraint warrant pertaining to a tax debt and requests the recipient to contact a toll-free phone number. Citizens are urged to shred the mailed notification and to not contact the phone number listed on the letter. Distraint warrants are issued by state tax commissions, and the IRS does not issue these warrants.

The Cumberland County Office of Consumer Protection and other county divisions are aware of this scam and are available to assist residents with any questions.


